Cancellation of Registration and Refund Policy:

Climate and Dress:

Transportation:**By plane**

Prague Ruzyně Airport, located 15 km from the city center is served by many international lines. The cost of a taxi from the Ruzyně Airport to the City is at present about 20 EUR. Shuttle bus service operates as well. City bus No. 119 will take you from the airport to the metro terminal Dejvicka. To get to the conference venue, buses No. 107 and 147 can be used.

By train and by car

Prague is easily reachable by rail as well as by car. If you arrive by train, you will find a metro station on line C at the Central Railway Station or at the Holešovice Railway Station. At the metro station Museum you will change for metro line A and go to the terminal Dejvicka.

City Transportation

Prague has a comprehensive network of public transportation consisting of metro, trams and buses. Single tickets or travel passes can be purchased at most newspaper stands and from the coin machines at metro and some tram/bus stations.

Car Rental:

Most of the major car rental companies (Hertz etc.) have offices in Prague. Detailed information is available from the conference secretariat. We strictly recommend making reservations in advance.

Official Letter of Invitation:

An official letter of invitation can be sent on request. It must be understood that such a letter cannot grant any financial support.

Visas:

Participants from most European countries and the USA can enter the Czech Republic without a visa. Other participants are advised to check the requirements at the closest Embassy or Consulate of the Czech Republic and to make their own arrangements.
