The knowledge the students will acquire from this scholarship will benefit both the scholars and the research community in their own countries. Students must be from one of the following eligible countries:

Afghanistan, Albania, Algeria, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia and Herzegovina, China, Croatia, Ethiopia, Georgia, India, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Laos, Macedonia, Moldova, Mongolia, Montenegro, Serbia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Vietnam.

Students who are awarded the scholarship will have tuition, books, and subsistence costs covered by Hungarian Universities for the entire duration of their studies. The scholarship funding covers student costs only and cannot be extended to cover costs related to family members. The students will be responsible for finding financial support for their travel to and from Hungary.

For your convenience I have attached detailed information on the Master's programme and application procedures as well as the Application.

Please note that the deadline by which Applications must reach FAO is 15 April 2009.
